

# QUEEN ROSE HIKING TRAILS

## Rules & Regulations for Day Hikers Visiting the Trails

- The latest start time for any trails will be 09:00. No Hikers will be allowed to hike any trails starting later than 09:00.
- No hiker will hike alone on any of our trails.
- No fires except in braai drums, located in the camp site area.
- Braai drums not to be moved from braai areas.
- Fires never to be left unattended.
- No large fires allowed – The entire area is a high fire risk area.
- No fires permitted on days that have a high Fire Danger Index – Orange and / or red.
- Fire to be extinguished before going to sleep using the provided water buckets, or hose.
- Hikers will be held legally responsible for any fire related damages to the huts or properties.
- No loud music.
- Drunken and disorderly behavior will not be tolerated.
- No littering.
- All rubbish to be discarded in the dustbins provided and not burnt.
- No smoking on the trails, where vegetation can catch fire.
- All cigarette buds (or other smoking methods) to be extinguished and disposed of properly. (not discarded in the environment)
- Only wood purchased from Queen Rose Hiking Trails to be used for fires. No trees / shrubs / bushes or plants to be used as firewood.
- Any vandalism to the huts or furniture will be charged for.
- Any gates found closed must be closed once passed through.
- Any gates found locked must be locked once passed through.
- Do not attempt to feed, chase or aggravate any wild animals.
- Fishing in the dams is on a catch and release basis only.
- Swimming in the dams or rivers is at your own risk. Take note that the rocks are slippery and that there are high chances of slip and fall.
- No foreign objects to be flushed down the toilets – Use bins provided for female sanitary towels.
- Only booked hikers to have use of the huts.
- Children to be supervised by adults and never left to own devices.
- No Alcohol allowed on the trails
- Queen Rose Hiking Trail's radios are there for emergencies only, or if assistance is required
- Hikers accepting Queen Rose Hiking Trail's radios will be liable for any deliberate damage to the radios
- Hikers to bring their own radios for communication between groups.
- Once the whole group has arrived at the parking area, the Group Leader to radio / message, Queens to inform us of the group's arrival.

- Take care off you're footing at all times.
- A levy will be charged to pick-up hikers that need assistance.
- Note the following pick-up points:  
 Matumi Bush Camp  
 Matumi 16  
 Matumi 18  
 Matumi 24  
 Cupid Falls  
 Oukraal Stone Henge / Plantation

### Hiking Guide Lines

- Stay on the designated trails
- Stay in-touch with the group
- Wet and/or shiny areas are slippery, as such take small steps when walking.
- Drink plenty of hydrating fluids
- Where protective hats
- Where comfortable shoes or boots made for hiking
- Matumi & Oukraal hikers. Remember the dirt road that you use and cross every now and then are your central point
